Law Enforcement Leaders Continue to Line Up Behind Judge Gableman

Only candidate for Supreme Court with law enforcement experience backed by additional sheriffs, district attorney.

[Burnett County, Wisc....] Judge Gableman's campaign for Supreme Court announced the endorsements of three additional law enforcement officials today. Sauk County Sheriff Randy Stammen, Winnebago County Sheriff Michael Brooks, and Dunn County District Attorney James Peterson have all added their names to the growing list of Gableman supporters.
