VFA Endorse Judge Gableman for State Supreme Court

The political action arm of the Wisconsin Farm Bureau has endorsed Judge Michael Gableman for the State Supreme Court. The Volunteers for Agriculture says Judge Gableman would be the stronger candidate when it comes to protecting the state's Right to Farm law, which has come up in the news a lot during the past year while watching the controversial case between a northern Wisconsin cranberry grower and a group of near-by landowners.

"Judge Gableman is a judge that our committee believes will protect our right to farm in Wisconsin," said Pam Garvey, chair of the Volunteers for Agriculture and Polk County Farm Bureau member. "Wisconsin farmers recognize that state government is a system of checks and balances, and it is important to us to elect justices that will not legislate from the bench. We appreciate that Judge Gableman strongly agrees with this viewpoint."

Garvey reminded voters that as issues to Wisconsin's \$51 billion agriculture industry come before the high court, it is important for farmers to participate in Supreme Court elections.

The Volunteers for Agriculture was established in 1988 with the primary goal of increasing the involvement of the agricultural community in the political process.
